**CONDITIONS**

- All entrants assent to be bound by Golf Australia's Code of Conduct (inc. abusive or profane language and failure to fill in divots or repair pitch marks). Copies of these will be available at the course.
- Events are open to amateur golfers only who are members and associates of golf clubs registered with Golf Tasmania or golf clubs outside the State of Tasmania registered with a similar Association and the Committee shall have the right to refuse entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- All events shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as currently adopted by R&A Rules Limited, Scotland, together with such proper Local Rules of the Greens Beach Golf Club.
- In the event of a player failing to hand in a card and satisfactorily explaining the omission to the Championship Committee, the player will be disqualified from all events in the Championship.
- Disputes are to be in writing and lodged within five (5) minutes of the completion of play addressed to the Tournament Committee, Tamar Valley Championship. The decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final.
- The Tournament Committee reserves the right to modify starting times, alter the handicap of any entrant before they start, limit the field should it be deemed desirable and to take such action as it considers necessary for the good conduct of the tournament.
- Should two or more competitors tie in events 1, 3, 5 or 7, 45 Hole Scratch, they shall play a sudden-death play-off on holes nominated by the Tournament Committee. All other ties shall be decided on count back.
- Eligible players for the Men's Championship are male amateurs whose Australian Men's Handicap does not exceed 13.4 strokes.
- It is the duty of each player TO REPORT TO THE STARTER 15 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE TIME APPOINTED TO PLAY and also advise the starter of any changes in handicap at the time of entry.
- The exact handicap certified as at the commencement of the first round is the handicap to be used for all purposes.
- A draw will be made and published. Players shall start at the time laid down by the Committee. Rule 6-3a provides: "The players shall start at the time laid down by the Committee." The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However, it is a condition of this Championship that in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if a player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five (5) minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes, instead of disqualification.
- Competitors are required to observe the dress regulations of the host club at all times.
- Pace of Play:** Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute them to such delay. **Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.**
- The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards to Conforming Golf Balls, One Ball Condition and Time of Starting.
- A player may obtain distance information using a device that measures distance only. If during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, windspeed, temperature, etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.
- During a round, competitors may not travel in or on any motorised vehicle without the prior approval from the Tournament Committee.
